You are invited to be a member of Crisis Centre Ministries. Being a member of Crisis Centre Ministries (CCM) allows you to play a key role by having a say in our plans and in supporting the work.

Why should I become a member of CCM?

The most important duties of a member of CCM are to pray for the work, promote the ministry among your network of church, friends and family, and to get involved as you are able through volunteering and giving.

CCM has a Statement of Faith and we would expect members to align themselves to this. Our Memorandum and Articles of Association state the legal basis on which the Association has members, as well as the obligations and restrictions on membership. Included in them is the obligation of each member, in the event of CCM having to wind up because of debts to contribute an amount not exceeding £10. We sincerely hope it won't come to that! As a member, you are also expected to attend the AGM at which you will hear reports of the work, receive the annual accounts and help us decide on key issues and elect trustees.

Other details you should know - Crisis Centre Ministries is the trading name of Crisis Centre Limited, a company limited by guarantee under the Companies Act (Company Number 2214814), and a charity covered by the Charities Act (Charity Number 298528).
